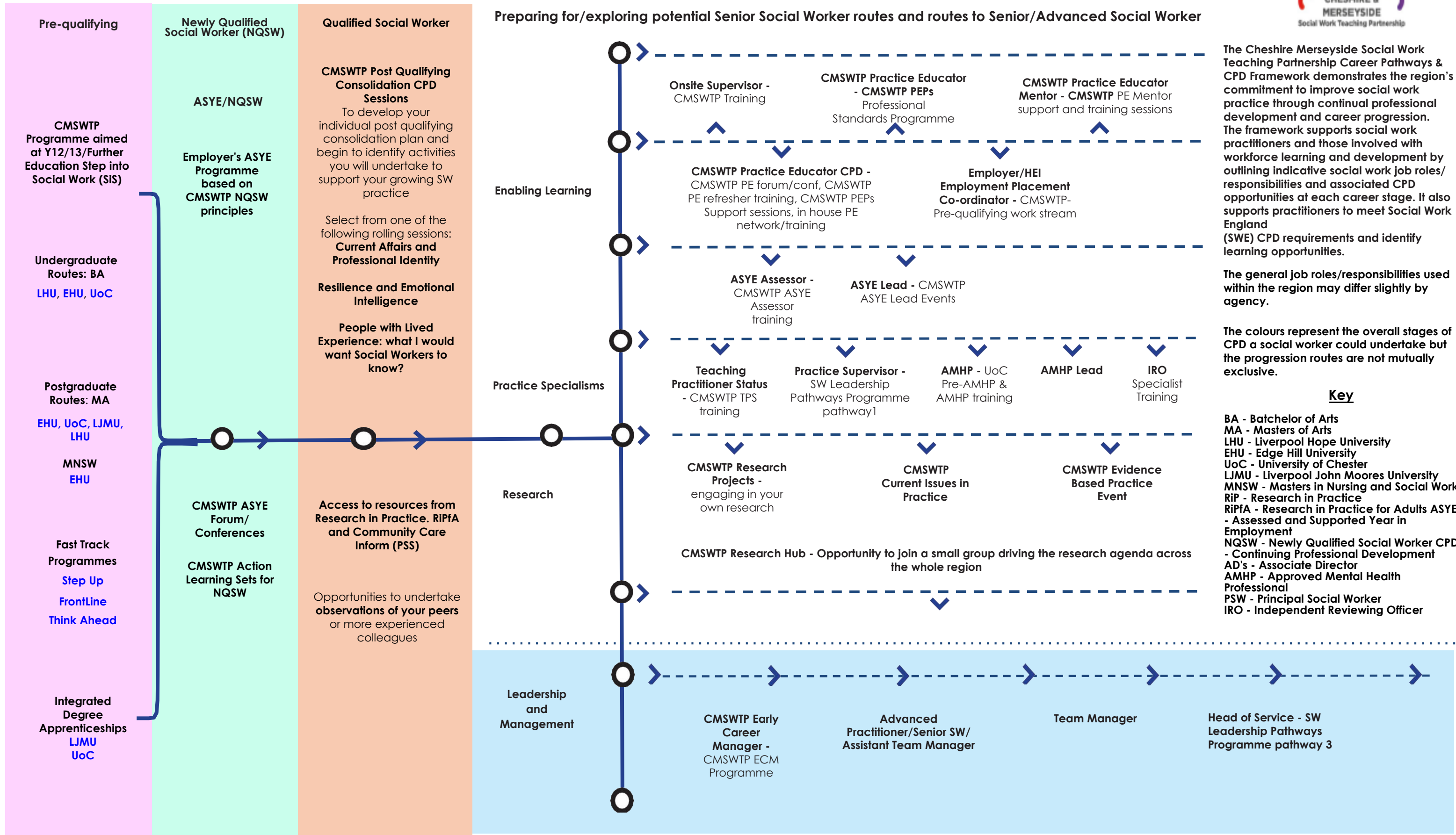


Career Pathways & CPD Framework



The Cheshire Merseyside Social Work Teaching Partnership Career Pathways & CPD Framework demonstrates the region's commitment to improve social work practice through continual professional development and career progression. The framework supports social work practitioners and those involved with workforce learning and development by outlining indicative social work job roles/responsibilities and associated CPD opportunities at each career stage. It also supports practitioners to meet Social Work England (SWE) CPD requirements and identify learning opportunities.

The general job roles/responsibilities used within the region may differ slightly by agency.

The colours represent the overall stages of CPD a social worker could undertake but the progression routes are not mutually exclusive.
